

Healing Scriptures

You will learn to stress less as you restore, heal, and deepen your relationship with God. The following truths from God's Word give you assurances about his healing power in your life. In the first section, I have paraphrased biblical promises regarding healing, followed by the book and verses in the Bible that contain them. The second section includes additional quoted scriptures I encourage you to look up and meditate on each of these truths and read the corresponding verses. The final section is a list of biblically based affirmations to help you speak the truth about God's healing in your life. Allow yourself to receive comfort, peace, joy, and encouragement from these truths.

Promises from God's Word

Whatever you ask in prayer believe you will receive it and it shall be yours. [Matthew 21:22; Mark 11:24]

As I hope in the Lord, he will renew my strength, and I will run and not grow weary and I will walk and not faint. [Isaiah 40:31]

The Lord brings health and cure. He has cured you and revealed to you an abundance of peace and truth. [Jeremiah 33:6]

Your faith has healed you, go forth now and be free of your suffering. [Mark 5:34; Matthew 9:22; Luke 8:47]

I trust that you prosper and be in good health, as your soul prospers. [3 John 1:2]

When I touch his robe, I am healed. [Matthew 9:21; Mark 5:28]

By faith in his name I am made strong and given perfect health. [Acts 3:16]

Beloved your faith has made you well, go in peace and be healed of all your disease. [Mark 5:34]

Your words are life and health to all my flesh. [Proverbs 4:20–22]

By his stripes I am healed. [Isaiah 53:5; 1 Peter 2:24]

He sent his word and it healed them. [Psalm 107:20]

Bless the Lord, who heals all diseases. [Psalm 103:2–3]

Ask and it is given. Our Father in heaven gives good things to those who ask. [Matthew 7:7, 11]

The grace of the Lord is exceedingly abundant, with faith, love, and wellbeing. [1 Timothy 1:14]

God supplies all of my needs. [Philippians 4:19]
